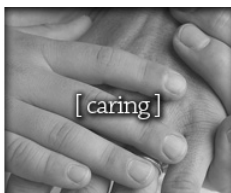
butterflies. So, have some fun. Be creative and share God's love on the upcoming flights.

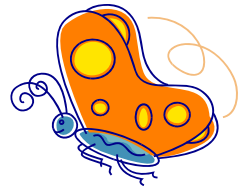
